

INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT: FOUNDATION SCHOOLS

This Instrument of Government replaces the Instrument of Government for Moss Lane School made by Surrey County Council that came into effect on 7th October 2021.

1. The name of the school is Moss Lane School.
2. The school is a foundation school.
3. The name of the governing body is “the governing body of Moss Lane School”.
4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - a) 2 parent governors
 - b) 1 local authority governor
 - c) 1 headteacher
 - d) 1 staff governor
 - e) 2 co-opted governors
 - f) 2 foundation governors
5. The total number of governors shall be 9.
6. The name of the body entitled to appoint foundation governors is Godalming Learning Partnership.
7. The School has a trust entitled Godalming Learning Partnership.
8. The term of office for all governors is 3 years.
9. This Instrument of Government comes into effect on 16th February 2026.
10. This instrument was made by order of Surrey County Council on **17th February 2026**
11. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every governor and associate member of the governing body (and the headteacher if not a governor).
